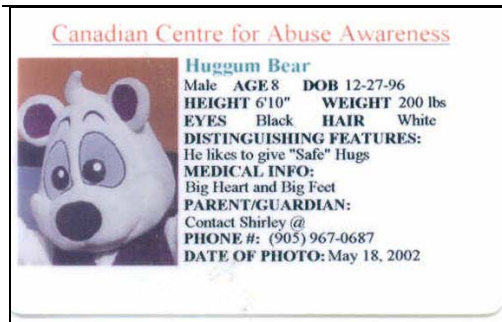


ID Card Example

HOW TO GET YOUR CHILD'S PERSONAL ID KIT

CCAA offers a full and comprehensive array of program services to address the needs of both children and adults.

ABOUT THE ID PROCESS

Missing children - what could be worse than your child being gone, it can happen in an instant and in some cases turn out with a fatal ending. It is imperative to know the information required by police so they can quickly identify your child. This is going to sound horrible but you often cannot as parents give accurate descriptions of your own children when you are in a panicked situation. Panic is a parent's worst enemy and who isn't going to panic when your child is suddenly gone.

We have an ID Kit that has been created which includes a plastic photo id card with all details of your child that are laid out in the same way as the information would be collected using current Policing technology. This helps us to eliminate time with the police and they can easily have the information entered into their system to file a missing person's report. Your card is kept with you at all times just like any identification card; it's the same size as a driver's license therefore will fit in your wallet easily. This ID kit also contains a DNA collection kit and finger print strips that parents will keep in their home in case it is ever required. At the same time we hand out fun educational material for the children and to the parents two brochures on safe touching and how to talk to your teens. The card is not only useful for children but for all ages as photo ID, including aging people, for example, who might have Alzheimer's disease.

If you are having an event where you believe an ID station would be beneficial to the group, call the office and we will send the ID Team, which includes our Huggum Bear Mascot, balloons for the children, and a team of people who will photograph and measure the height and weight of your child. Once all information is collected we then take the photo to our office and produce the plastic ID Card which is then mailed to you. We DESTROY the information after 3 weeks of sending out the cards. If there is a mistake on the card it's very important that you let us know right away so that we can make any changes while we still have the card information in our system.
