at Oakside Drive and Centre Road (see map)**


Bring the kids and join the fun! Why not plan to walk the trail either before or after the ceremony -- it will be fully marked and signed.

The MapleBridge Trail is the seventh in the system of Town Trails, all marked and posted, designed for walkers, runners and bikers. The wide variety of trail offer opportunities for all ages and abilities. The trails aim to help us to appreciate the beauty of our town, to link the various sections of the town together for walkers and bikers, to encourage us to improve our health in the outdoors, and to foster an appreciation of our natural environment. Eventually, the Town Trails will link with an extensive network of Countryside Trails, and with the two major trails passing through Uxbridge -- the Trans-Canada Trail and the Oak Ridges Trail.

Put all of these trails together, and you can see why we're calling Uxbridge "The Trail Capital of Canada".
